### Delta Kappa Gamma

#### Scholarship and Stipend Guidelines

1. Applicants must be a member of an active Delta Kappa Gamma chapter in Washington State for at least 2 full years prior to the application deadline date. Example: Applicants applying for a scholarship in 2019 must have been initiated by February 1, 2017.
2. A state scholarship is given for the following:
  - Advanced studies
  - Graduate degrees
  - Certifications and endorsements
  - Graduate studies
3. A state stipend is given for the following:
  - Specialized studies
  - Workshops
  - Conferences
  - Other education events
  - Retreats
  - Conferences
  - Other professional and personal growth activities
4. Applications for funding any of the activities listed in #2 and 3 above that were completed prior to the scholarship deadline will not be considered.
5. The letters of recommendation must include at least one letter from the applicant's chapter membership.
6. Completed application and letters of recommendation must be received by the scholarship chairperson by the deadline date. Incomplete applications will not be considered and the committee will not wait after the deadline date for completed applications or letters of recommendation to be received. It is up to the applicant to verify that letters of recommendation have been received by the deadline date.
7. The scholarship/stipend recipients as well as those not receiving a scholarship/stipend will be notified by the last day in March. Upon being notified, recipients are expected to submit a picture to be used in the Alpha Sigma News.
8. The above will be invited to the scholarship luncheon at the State Convention if a convention is held that year. Since recipients are already members, they will be expected to pay their own expenses for attending.

9. Within 90 days of completion of their work, recipients must submit the following:
- a brief summary of the work completed
  - original receipts equivalent to the scholarship or stipend award
  - a brief synopsis of the plan for sharing what she learned with the community, chapter, or state organization
