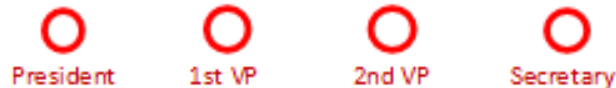


Who's Who in Washington State Organization

Governing Bodies

State Executive COMMITTEE

Elected Officers



- Elected by voting Officers and Chapter Presidents to a 2-year term.
- Officers set the overall direction of WSO for the biennium.

Selected & confirmed:

Appointed:



- Treasurer and Executive Secretary: 4-year terms.
- Immediate Past President & Parliamentarian: 2-year terms
- Executive Secretary and Parliamentarian do not vote.
- All these officers keep the committee machinery functioning.

State Executive BOARD

All Officers, plus



Chapter Presidents

- Elected by the respective Chapter Members to a 2-yr term.
- The President (and her Chapter Officers) set the overall Chapter direction.
- Presidents represent their Chapters at the State level.

Non-Governing Bodies

- Group meets once a year to advise and encourage the current leadership.

Committee Chairs

- The State Executive Council is a non-governing body focusing on communication between the Executive Committee and various state-wide teams.
- Liaisons are selected by the president and serve a 2-year term.
- Area Liaisons work with each Chapter in a given geographical area.
- Nomination Committee members and RRPSF trustees are elected by the State Executive Board.
- Other committee chairs are appointed and committee members are recruited. Committees usually have a specific time-frame and focus.

⇒ Business Committees:

Bylaws & Rules—Leadership—Finance—Membership, etc., etc.

⇒ Mission & Purpose Committees:

Educational Excellence—Educational Policy & Legislation

⇒ Special and Ad-Hoc Committees:

Creative Arts Retreat—Minutes Review—RRPSF, etc., etc.
