The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International was founded in Texas in 1929 by Annie Webb Blanton and 11 other women educators who were pioneers in improving the status of women in education.

The movement spread nationwide and in 1941, the first Washington State Chapter began as Alpha Sigma State. Today, our state has 33 chapters and 817 members.

Local, State & International Members are from 17 nations in Europe, North and Central America, and most recently, in Japan.

Membership is by invitation only. Prospective members are encouraged to attend chapter meeting as a guest to learn more about the Society and each chapter's unique programs, activities and special projects.
